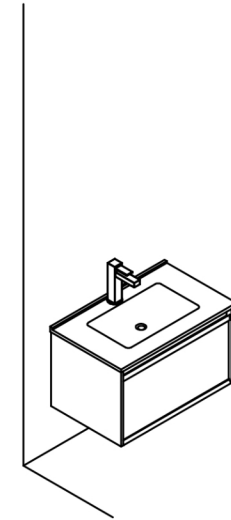
Faucet installation: Install the faucet on the basin. Ensure all connections are properly tightened with no water leakage. Secure the faucet without over-twisting the connections.
